### Level 1

### Level 3

What is a ...? (define)  
How did s/he feel?  
What have they done so far?  
Tell me about the story.

### Level 4



What might happen if he ...?  
Why do you think ...?  
How did that happen?  
How do you know ...?  
What could s/he do?  
What would you do if ...?  
Why is it made of that?  
Why can't he ...?  
If you were him/her, what  
would you say or do?  
What do you need to ...?  
Why is this called a ...?  
(compound word)
